Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) is a local food subscription that you sign up for in advance for a specific number of weeks. This subscription is often called a "farm share." CSA farms in Kentucky offer farm shares for produce, meat, eggs, flowers, herbs, and more.

What is Community Supported Agriculture?

The upfront commitment to purchasing is one of the most critical aspects of CSA. It offers the farm more financial support as they prepare for the upcoming growing season and a more secure market for their products. In return, community members gain access to some of the freshest locally-grown products and develop a relationship with a farm for a whole season.

Save the date for KY Proud CSA Week!


