NOW OPEN! The \$7 billion [Solar for All grant competition](#) will expand the number of low-income and disadvantaged communities primed for residential solar investment. Up to 60 grants will be awarded to states, territories, Tribal governments, municipalities, and eligible nonprofits to create and expand low-income solar programs that provide financing and technical assistance, such as workforce development, to enable low-income and disadvantaged communities to deploy and benefit from residential solar. COMING SOON: Applications are expected to open this summer for two additional [Greenhouse Gas Reduction Fund](#) grant opportunities — the Clean Communities Investment Accelerator and National Clean Investment Fund. These competitive grants will mobilize financing and leverage private capital for clean energy and climate projects with an emphasis on projects that benefit low-income and disadvantaged communities.
