Pray that the political and military unrest around the world will bring people face-to-face with their need for the one and only Savior, Jesus Christ. Pray for missionaries and the local ministry leaders who are faithfully being used to show the salvation of God to those in war-torn areas of the world.



### CPFI Board and Officers

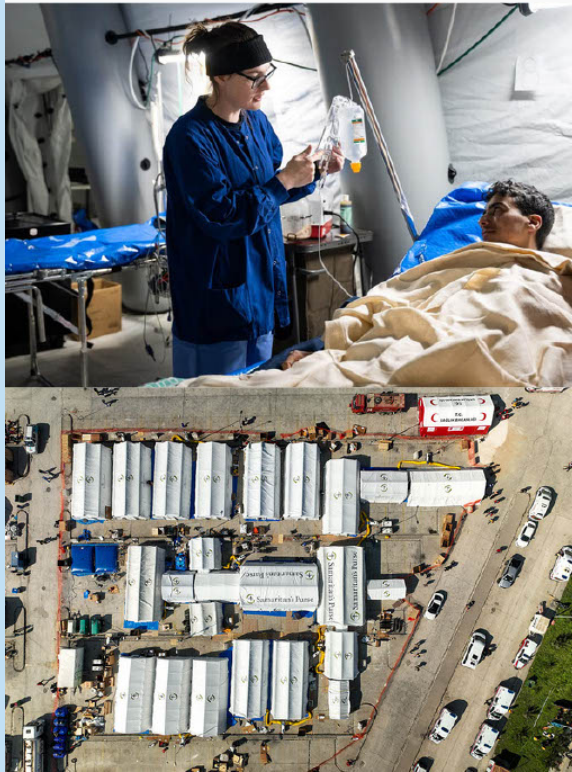
